#### 1. ЦЕЛИ ОСВОЕНИЯ ДИСЦИПЛИНЫ

Целью освоения дисциплины "Практика устной и письменной речи" является обучение устной и письменной речи на основе развития автоматизированных речевых навыков и навыков письма, развития техники чтения и умения понимать английский текст, содержащий усвоенную ранее фонетику, лексику и грамматику, а также развитие письменной речи на основе ранее полученных умений и навыков, включающих умения и навыки, полученные по таким аспектам, как фонетика, грамматика и практика устной и письменной речи. Таким образом, данная дисциплина не может выступать отдельно от других модулей, связанных с изучением английского языка и в этом проявляется её междисциплинарный характер.
